

AYSO, Region 297 Hall of Fame (HoF) Criteria

To be eligible for the Region 297 Hall of Fame the candidate must possess the following Qualifications:

- Been an active member of the Region 297 Board of Directors or Support Staff; been a coach or a referee; or provided significant contributions to the Region over a minimum of six years (or two terms for members of the Board of Directors and Support Staff) at the end of the current Spring Season.
- Actively promoted the betterment of the region
- Be a recognized AYSO person both to the outside and inside (Region 297) soccer world
- Be a continuing role model for all volunteers, parents, and players.

All nominations should be submitted in writing to the regional commissioner no later than 16 April of that current year.. Nominations will include the name of the nominee, the reasons they are nominated, and the contributions they have made to the region. The nominations will be forward to Hall of Fame Committee (past Hall of Fame members) for evaluation. The consensus is passed to the Regional Commissioner for final determination

The results will be made known at the Volunteer Dinner/Picnic at the end of the Spring Season.

A Regional Board member will be designated to complete the administrative process

The selected HoF individual(s) will be recognized at the Volunteer Picnic/Dinner and given an AYSO Jacket, with the individual's name, the region number, and "Hall of Fame (year)". They will also receive an individual plaque recognizing their contributions to the region. The selected individual will also have their name put on the Regional Hall of Fame Plaque with all the previous winners. This plaque will be displayed in a place of prominence at the selected individuals school or area (this is subject to approval by the school or area). In addition the HoF individual will have their name placed on the HoF Billboard at the Gorman Soccer Complex.

A portion of the Region 297 Web Site will be dedicated to the Hall of Fame. The members will be recognized along with a brief summary of their contributions.
